If your images are suitable for a **scientific article** or to illustrate an encyclopedia or newspaper article, then they are also suitable for this competition. Register at commons.wikimedia.org, providing your e-mail address.

Images must have a good scientific description!

Warning! The user must also be the author of the shots (except for institutional accounts).

Each image will become part of Wikimedia Commons, the multimedia database of Wikipedia and must be released under **free license** (e.g. CC-BY-SA 4.0).
